President's Report

February 8, 2010

1. Water Tower Grants – I spoke with the Governors office again. Our payments for the two grants are on his desk waiting for approval. Let's keep our fingers crossed that he will sign off on our payments very soon. In speaking with this person, she told me that our \$100,000 for Infrastructure repairs is also on his desk. We'll see what happens. I stay on this.
2. Phoenix Fabricators. Again, we'll need to make another payment of \$5000.00 to Phoenix. I spoke with Phoenix last week and told them where we were at with the State and close to getting paid. I told them that they are tops on the list to getting paid. I'll keep in contact with them.
3. Committee Meetings – I would like for the Zoning Committee to have a meeting to discuss the use of Trailers as a source of storage used to run a business. Again, this use of a trail circumvents our taxing abilities and building codes. It appears that we need to change our ordinance to prohibit this type of activities.
4. Federally funded projects – US Rep. Halverson has requested projects from her Municipalities that would be paid for with Federal funds. I contacted Neil and he will be submitting three projects for us. The projects will cover a water main, sanitary sewer main and a road project. The deadline for these submissions is Feb. 12th.
5. River Valley Metro – I attended a meeting this past month at the River Valley Metro office. At this meeting were the Mayors from Momence, Sun River, Hopkins Park and myself. We met with Robert Hoffmann and Michelle Brutlag. We discussed the possibilities of extended services for the Metro line to the eastern part of Kankakee County and how it might work. We will be scheduling a follow up meeting in the near future.
