## **President's Report**

**April 13, 2015**

- 1. Darrin Lee** – I would like to take this opportunity to thank Darrin Lee for his 8 years of Service to the Village Board. Darrin's Dedication and passion for the Village will be missed. With that being said, I would like to welcome Lucas O'Connell to our Board. In addition, I have attached the new Committee assignments for the next couple of years. If anyone would like a change please let me know.
- 2. Street Surfacing**– Terry and Don meet with Dave Tyson on Friday the 10<sup>th</sup>. Terry will have a report on what they discussed.
- 3. New Village Hall/Community Center** – I spoke with Todd Sirois about this project. We're going to have a meeting this month with Mike VanMill to discuss our funding options for this project. I'll report on this meeting at our next meeting.
- 4. Building at 167 W Station Street** – I spoke with the County and the Trustee, a Mr. Bill Krieger, concerning the building at 167 W. Station Street. Apparently, the person who was to purchase the building at the Tax Sale defaulted on the payment thus; the building is still in the hands of the County. We discussed the falling bricks and the awning that is about to fall off. The Trustee told me that we have the right to secure the building for safety reasons without their approval. In addition, the Trustee would be willing to sell us the building for minimum amount of \$647.00. I feel if we could find someone who would be willing to fix up the building and get it back on the tax role, then we could purchase the building and sell it to that person for a nominal amount. Otherwise, this building will continue to be a thorn in our side.
