The Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity has completed its review of all 2013 Public Infrastructure applications submitted for consideration under the Community Development Assistance Program (CDAP). As a result of the review, I am sorry to inform you that your project was not selected for funding.

For the 2013 Program Year, the department received 103 applications submitted from counties across Illinois. The funds requested totaled \$40 million dollars. However, only nine million dollars is available for funding. Each application was reviewed to ensure compliance with all published guidelines, rated and ranked accordingly. Funds are awarded to applicants based on rank until funds are exhausted.

If you wish to apply for funding in fiscal year 2014, the application will be available on our *new* website: www.Illinois.gov/dceo in February and due June 2nd. In addition, we will be hosting a workshop for grantees and applicants in Springfield on March 11th, 2014, more details to follow.
