- 1. Eastern Illinois Street project. - This project is proceeding and we have the funds.
- 2. **Bar open after hour's complaint** – We have received a second incident report on this establishment having customers in the bar after hours. According to Counsel we will need to issue a citation for this offense. Once we issue a citation, then the next step will be to suspend the liquor license for a minimum of 24 hours. The License Committee and I agree that this suspension will be on either a Friday or a Saturday. This will underscore the seriousness of these infractions. Again, I will keep you posted on this issue.
- 3. **Dandurand Easement** – We're still working on a solution for this issue. Once we have more on this issue I will let you know.
- 4th of July Celebration The Village Park Equipment committee is planning a 4. fundraiser this 4th of July weekend. I have spoken with Bill Jennings about the Village providing the Fireworks at this event. Bill has secured a price of \$2500.00 from our regular vendor for their normal show. I feel that this is a very reasonable price and I would like to present this for approval at next months meeting. It's been a few years since we have had a Fireworks show and I personally think the residents will appreciate the celebration.
- 5. Pumpkin festival Committee – I attended the last committee meeting a couple of weeks ago. At this meeting we discussed how we're going move forward with this year's event. Bob Hubert is going to remain as President of this committee. We have not had anyone from the community step up to take Becky and Steve Arseneau's position as director. To solve this problem we will be looking to get some of our younger residents involved in the planning and execution of the event. This will help breath new life into the event, while at the same time start to train these new members to eventually take over the event and secure it's future.
