

ORDINANCE NO. 12-_____
ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3-1-16
VILLAGE OF ST. ANNE, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

3-1-16:CLOSING HOURS: It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the Village between the hours of one o'clock (1:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. of any day except Saturday and Sunday; and every Saturday and Sunday between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. Saturday and between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and twelve o'clock (12:00) noon on Sunday.

It shall be unlawful to keep open for business or to admit to the public to any premises in or on which alcoholic liquor is sold at retail holding a Class A license during the hours within which the sale of such liquor is prohibited and no alcoholic liquor may be sold to or consumed by the public during such hours.

It shall be unlawful for any business holding at Class B license, from selling, providing, giving, charging or otherwise transferring alcoholic liquor during the hours within which the sale of liquor is prohibited pursuant to this ordinance and no alcoholic liquor may be consumed by the public during such hours.

WHEREBY IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED THAT SECTION 3-1-16 SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

3-1-16:CLOSING HOURS: It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the Village between the hours of one o'clock (1:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. of any day except Saturday and Sunday; and every Saturday and Sunday between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. Saturday and between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and twelve o'clock (12:00) noon on Sunday, also between the hours of four o'clock (4:00) A.M. on December 31st and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. on January 1st if January 1st falls on any day except for Sunday, then between the hours of four o'clock (4:00) A.M. on December 31st and 12:00 o'clock (12:00) P.M. if January 1st is a Sunday.

It shall be unlawful to keep open for business or to admit to the public to any premises in or on which alcoholic liquor is sold at retail holding a Class A license during the hours within which the sale of such liquor is prohibited and no alcoholic liquor may be sold to or consumed by the public during such hours.

It shall be unlawful for any business holding at Class B license, from selling, providing, giving, charging or otherwise transferring alcoholic liquor during the hours within which the sale of liquor is prohibited pursuant to this ordinance and no alcoholic liquor may be consumed by the public during such hours.

This Amendment shall become effective thirty days following publication.
