# Regular Board Meeting Board of Trustees of the Village of St. Anne Kankakee County, Illinois Village Hall, S, 2022

President O'Connell called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Clerk Sutherland called the roll, and the following trustees answered present: Grubbs, O'Connell, Abrassart, and Farber. Trustees Wendt and Stam were absent. Clerk Sutherland reported the roll, and President O'Connell declared that a quorum existed for the transaction of public business. Also present at the meeting was Treasurer Sue Bonvallet, and Rev Bob from the Wichert Reformed Church.

PPL. WITH PRESENTATIONS

President O'Connell asked if there were any questions or corrections to the minutes of the August 8, 2022 regular meeting. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to approve them. It was moved by Trustee Abrassart and seconded by Trustee Farber that the minutes be approved. Upon voice vote, all trustees present voted favorably, and President O'Connell declared the motion passed.

After hearing none, he asked for a motion to approve them. Motion was made by Trustee O'Connell, seconded by Trustee Farber, and after a voice vote, where all present voted favorably, the motion was carried.

Treasurer Bonvallet reported on the Village accounts. President O'Connell then asked if there were any questions or comments on her report. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to approve the report. It was moved by Trustee Farber and seconded by Trustee Grubbs that the treasurer's report be approved. After a roll call vote, where all present voted favorably, the motion was passed.

After a short discussion, the Board said that if kids walked around gates at the ponds to fish, it would be okay. The main reason for the barricade being closed at dark, was to control cars back there.

President O'Connell asked for final thoughts on what the Board wanted to do about water bill forgiveness for the house owned by Alex Boehrnsen. It was decided that he should be charged the regular rate.

President O'Connell informed the Board that he had communicated with another digital sign company. He feels that this company has a sign closer to the price the Village would feel comfortable with.

President O'Connell asked for a motion to issue Special Event Liquor licenses to Buckwild and The Office Too for the beer tents on Sept. 16 and 17. 2022. A motion was made by Trustee Farber, seconded by Trustee O'Connell and after a roll call vote, where all present voted favorably the motion was carried.

**ATTORNEY'S REPORT** 

Attorney Parish has also been in contact with Dawn Klonowski Korba on the LAND Agnes Klonowski property.

Trustee Farber gave the police report. He read the report as follows: 9 traffic stops. 1 accident, 20 agency assists, including ambulance, fire, and other agencies. 4 suspicious activity/vehicles responses, 124 business checks, park checks, 11 citations were issued, 0 arrests, 0 disorderly conduct disturbance,0 battery, agg battery, domestic battery, 0 criminal damage to property/vehicles, and 9 ordinance violation notices. There was \$0 for the vehicle fund, \$279.50 in fines, \$14.00 in e-citation funds, \$0 in administrative vehicle seizures, \$0 In Sex/Violent Offender registration, \$0 in warrant fees and \$433.50 disbursement from the County Clerk, and also received payment from Papineau for \$600. There was \$0 collected in golf cart fees. The August total was \$1033.50.

**POLICE REPORT:** 

Trustee O'Connell read a list of equipment that former resident, Thomas Cotton offered the Village at the cost of \$6,090. After a short discussion, a motion was made by Trustee O'Connell to purchase the total list of materials. This was seconded by Trustee Abrassart, and after a roll call vote, where all present voted favorably, the motion was carried.

**PUBLIC WORKS RPT. SURPLUS SUPPLIES** FROM T. COTTON

The monthly building permit report was read by Trustee Farber. The cost of the approved projects was \$247,620 and the cost of the permits was \$1,491.
