- 2. Streetscape Project We are going to have a meeting with Neil to explore the possibility of having a downtown streetscape project. Neil's firm has had good success obtaining grants for these type projects. What's nice about these grants is they are funded at 80%. This first meeting will just be a bird's eye view of what all we need to do, what the costs for the plan will be and the steps we'll need to take in order to hit certain timeframes.
- **3. Solar Farm** I'm working with one of the local property owners on possibly using some of their acreage for this project. In addition, we might be able to use some of our property on the east side of the ponds.
- **4.
