POLICE REPORT

Trustee O'Connell gave the monthly Police report. Fines collected were \$1,121.58, \$0 warrant fees, and \$10.00 e-citations. There was \$0 in administrative tow fines, \$770.00 in golf cart fees, \$20.00 in Solicitor permits, \$0 in ordinance fines and \$900.00 collected from Papineau for a total of \$2,821.58.

Trustee O'Connell made the recommendation to hire 2 new officers. Brent Barrie as a part time officer and Eugene Hoffman as a full-time officer. Trustee Wendt seconded the motion. After a roll call vote where everyone in attendance voted favorably the motion was passed.

HIRING OF NEW OFFICERS

Trustee Miramontes gave the building permit report in Trustee Abrassart's absence. There was a total cost of \$67,900 and the fees were \$920.00

Trustee Miramontes stated that everything was going good with the parks.

PARKS AND BUILDINGEQUIP.

Trustee Dhans had nothing to report.

Trustee Stam reported that the bills had been examined by the committee and recommended for payment.
