POLICE REPORT

POLICE/JUDICIAL

Trustee O'Connell gave the monthly Police report. He read the report as follows: 27 traffic stops, 2 local citations, 12 written warnings, 15 traffic citations, 0 accident, 18 agency assists ambulance, fire, other agencies, 5 suspicious activity calls persons, vehicles, 2 arrest warrants/traffic/felony/misdemeanor, 0 notices to appear in lieu of bail, 1 disorderly conduct/disturbance/fireworks, 4 battery/agg battery, domestic battery/ fights, 0 admin tows, 2 criminal damage to property/vehicle, 4 theft/identity theft/shoplifting, 1 removal. Fines collected were \$96.00, \$0 warrant fees, and \$4.00 e-citations. There was \$0 in administrative tow fines, \$140 in golf cart fees, \$0 in ordinance fines and \$900.00 collected

from Papineau for a total of \$1140.00.

Trustee Wendt reported that most of the "speed bumps" in town have been ground down and filled in and they will be starting on the other intersections soon. The village employees will start their repairs on Eastern Illinois Ave with the help of Aroma Township on Wednesday. Trustee Wendt also stated that there are needed repairs on the backhoe to keep it operational. The quote was just under \$2000 for the repairs. President O'Connell also stated that there were some bigger potholes that need to be filled 6th Ave.

PUBLIC WORKS

Trustee Abrassart had nothing to report. Discussion was held on the FS expansion and the need to get all the inspections done and to calculate the fees to be paid out for the fees and inspections.

LICENSE AND HEALTH

Trustee Miramontes stated that the Pumpkin Fest Committee was very happy with how everything was handled at the park for the festival. Trustee O'Connell suggested getting a small heater to install in the concession stand to keep the pipes from freezing over the winter since all the repairs have been done to the bathrooms.

PARKS AND BUILDINGEQUIP.

Trustee Abrassart stated that they had received another quote for body cams, additional in-car cameras and tasers. The price for 5 body cams was \$8568.00, the price for the 2 in-car cameras was \$5030 and the price for 3 refurbished tasers came in at \$2097 for a total of \$15,995.00. This also includes the in-house server that will hold everything as long as needed. Trustee Abrassart made the motion to buy all 3 not to exceed \$16000.00. Trustee Stam seconded the motion. After a roll call vote where Trustee O'Connell voted present and Trustees Wendt, Abrassart, Stam, and Miramontes voted favorably the motion was passed.

EQUIPMENT/CIVIL DEFENSE

Trustee Stam reported that the bills had been examined by the committee and recommended for payment. It was moved by Trustee Stam, seconded by Trustee O'Connell that the above recommendation be approved, and the bills be authorized for payment. Upon roll call vote, where all present voted favorably, President O'Connell declared the motion carried.

PERSONNEL/FINANCE

Trustee Stam also made a motion to pay the IRMA insurance in 2 installments of 26,463.78. Trustee O'Connell seconded the motion and after a roll call vote where all present voted favorably the motion was passed.

IMRA INSURANCE

The President asked for any new or unfinished business.

NEW AND UNFINISHED

President O'Connell asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was made by Trustee Miramontes, seconded by Trustee Wendt, and after a voice vote, where all present voted favorably, the motion was carried, and President O'Connell then adjourned the meeting at 6:29p.m.
