## President's Report

September 8, 2025

1. **Streetscape Project** –Neil is working on this project and should have some feedback for us soon.
2. **Phase 3 & 4 Water Project** –**Phase 3** work is estimated to start October, 6<sup>th</sup>, after the Pumpkin Festival. Phase 4 should be going to bid in January of 2026.
3. **FS Grain 8500 Rd** – I have been working with FS and Neil on this project. FS would like us to take the lead on this road project. Essentially, Neil will be the engineer. We will receive the invoices from Neil and then FS will pay us for the invoices and we will make the corresponding payments to the vendors. This is the same process we have been using for the water projects. I have asked FS to have their attorneys draw up the agreement for this. Once I have that, I will have Trey go over the agreement before we present this to the board.
4. **FS Grain/Yellow Lights and Speed limit signs** – Don is working on finding these lights and signs for us. Once I have these, I will send FS the items that we would like to purchase for the safety of our students. FS has agreed to reimburse us the purchase of these items. We just need to let them help decide what we are purchasing.
5. **Speed Limits on Guertin Street and Route 1** – We have been talking to the State and to Kankakee County about the possibility of lowering the speed limits on these 2 streets to 25 mph. Especially, in the heart of the village leading to the schools. I know the speed limit is 20 mph in the school zones, but I think it would be wise to lower the speed limits leading into these zones. For example, on Rt 1 we slow traffic down starting at Ambrose St. all the way to the Village Sign on the south side of town. On Guertin street, we lower the speed limit from the railroad tracks, to the stop sign at route 1. The County has said we can do this, but we must buy the signs. I am waiting to hear back from the State to see if it will be the same thing as the county. I will keep you posted.
