## President's Report

February 9, 2026

- 1. Streetscape Project** –This Open House was well attended. There were a lot of good questions and concepts for the downtown project. Jody and Jill, from Teska, will be putting a concept together for us based on the feedback that the public gave them. We should have something back in a couple of months.
- 2. Phase 3 Water Project** –Phase 3 is going along nicely. We have had a couple of hiccups with service lines, but all in all, we are moving right along.
- 3. Phase 4 Water Project** – We have finalized the logos on the water tower. On the East and West sides will be the Village of St Anne, on the North side will be the SA logo and the South side will have the Cardinal head. Most of the tower will be black with a big white stripe on the main tower for the logos. We are using black to cover up the strains and dirt that accumulate on the base.
- 4. FS Grain 8500 Rd** –We are still waiting on the status of this project. Hopefully, we will have some plans in the next couple of weeks.
- 5. Tone Park** –Our ISLAD Grant was NOT picked up this year for the new park. We will be filling for the grant again later this year. This setback gives us a little more time to marry the Streetscape plans with the new park and even the renovation to the Tone building.
- 6. Tone Building Renovation** – Jerry and I meet with a couple people from the Carlile Group last week to discuss the renovation of the Tone building. The meeting was very positive and informative. They stated this is the type of work that they have a lot of experience in doing. In fact, their offices are in an old building in Manteno that they are currently renovating. They are very interested in this project and will be coming out to inspect the building for them to give us a realistic proposal to rehab this building bring it back to life.
